Sign up with Moved, your Move-in Portal

- Moved helps us gather the information we need to get ready for your arrival. Check your inbox for an invite from 'Moved'; if you do not see it, check your spam folder.

Package Deliveries

- We recommend that you do not have packages delivered to your apartment prior to your move in. Unclaimed boxes are a fire and tripping hazard.

Keys

Keys and access cards are available for pickup at the following locations and times.

April 7th - November 14th

Welcome Center (250 1st Avenue): Mon - Fri 10am-6pm; Sat 9am-4pm Public Safety (2 Stuy Oval): After hours, Sundays, and holidays

November 15th - April 6th

Resident Services (276 1st Avenue Loop): Mon-Fri 10am-6pm Public Safety: After hours, weekends, and holidays

 Please be advised while Public Safety operates 24 hours a day all year around, keys will only be available there, when our other 2 offices are closed. If your lease start date falls Monday-Saturday, keys and access cards will be ready at 4pm on the day prior to your lease start.

If your lease starts on Sunday or Monday, keys & access cards are available Saturday from 9am-4pm.

Please bring photo ID as keys will only be released to leaseholder(s).

Access Cards

Upload a headshot to Moved of you and any other member(s) of your household listed on the lease. You can also email the headshot(s). We'll use these to create your resident ID cards.

If emailing your photo(s), please make sure to:

- Include your full name, complete address, and a color photo.
- Use a clear image of your face: no hats, sunglasses, or filters.
- Stand in front of a plain background.

Parking Your Moving Truck

Moving trucks can park on the loop road nearest your building: 1st Ave Loop, 19th St Loop, 20th St Loop, Avenue C Loop, or Peter Cooper Road. There are no permits required; however, parking on pedestrian pathways is prohibited.

Boxes

Now that you're all moved in, you can recycle those boxes. Just break them down and place them next to the recycling bins located on the T Level in StuyTown and LL in Peter Cooper Village.

GOOD NEIGHBOR GUIDELINES

NYC is the city that never sleeps, but let's make sure your neighbors can.

Here are some simple guidelines to follow:

- **Carpets:** your lease requires that you cover at least 80% of your exposed floors (excluding kitchens and bathrooms).
- Quiet Hours:
 - Weekdays (incuding Friday morning): 11pm 7am
 - Weekends (beginning Friday night): midnight 9am
- Pets: if you need help registering your dog, visit: residents.stuytown.com/pet-policies-and-registration.
 - Please make sure your dog wears its community tag when outside.
 Doggy bag stations are placed around both communities.
- **Recycling:** there's a chute on your floor for landfill items. Recyclables go downstairs (T in StuyTown, LL in Peter Cooper Village).
- **Common Areas:** all common areas, including hallways, should be kept clear of personal items (umbrellas, strollers, packages, etc). Anything left in a common area is a fire and tripping hazard and will be removed. Access to the roof is not permitted across property.

Laundry Rooms: all buildings are equipped with coinless laundry facilities located on the T level in StuyTown and LL in Peter Cooper Village. They are open 24/7.

Bike Storage: stop by Public Safety (2 Stuyvesant Oval) to get your bike registered so you can store it in your building's bike room (T level in StuyTown and LL in Peter Cooper Village).

Recycling: bins are located on the T level in StuyTown and LL in Peter Cooper Village.

Rent Payment: rent is due on the 1st of each month. You can pay rent online using the resident web app at **app.beamliving.com**. Or, leave a check at a drop box around our two communities. Locations are:

Keys: need a key for your guest? You can order a set on the resident web app (app.beamliving. com) or by calling/texting 212.420.5000. Please be advised that personal Locksmiths are not allowed to remove/change locks or duplicate keys. Only tenants of record with photo ID can pick keys up. Keys are available for a fee:

- Apartment door: \$9.75 each
- Laundry/carriage room: \$9.75 each
- Mailbox: \$5.75 each
- Access card replacement: \$8.50 each
- Bike Room: \$9.75 each
- Lock Out Fee: \$55 plus tax

PARKING, STORAGE, & LAUNDRY


